



THEATRE ARTS CAMP 2020

Devising Theatre Day Camp

June 29 to July 3
Grades 7 to 9

Our day camps are intended to give participants the chance to learn collaboratively and experientially alongside their peers. Participants report that our camps have helped them to increase their self-confidence, further develop their skills as theatre artists and make new friends. In our programming, we aim to provide supportive communities of learning that emphasize having fun and creative playmaking.

DETAILS

Camps take place in the Stratford Normal School (270 Water St.) on the corner of Queen and Water in Stratford and run from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. each day. We break for lunch and nutritional snacks.

This program is presented in partnership with Cultivate, an art-based initiative that develops unique programs focusing on expanding the agency of young artists through interdisciplinary work and community-based approaches.

In this one-week play incubator camp, young people from Grades 7-9 are invited to join us to create a play together from scratch as a collective. To focus our creation, we will start from this year's theme of power, and explore where that takes us. We will engage in activities that develop skills in movement, writing, improvisation, design, and directing as we collaborate through the process. This camp culminates with a showcase of the play for friends, family, and the general public, followed by a talkback. Students are welcome to participate regardless of their prior level of experience with drama and theatre!

This camp includes a ticket to the 2 p.m. matinée of *Wendy & Peter Pan* on June 30th. Please note that there will be classes on July 1st.

INSTRUCTION

All of our programs are taught by theatre professionals with teaching experience who create dynamic programming for students of any age. Each session is led by a minimum of two adults.

MEALS & SNACKS

Lunch is included each day. Students should bring their own snacks.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

Space in the program is limited. Registration is first come, first served.
